Churchill Downs: Saturday, November 17, 2018

The homebred (#4) **WRATH** is an interesting proposition—especially at 6-1 on the morning line—in Saturday’s nightcap, “get out” race at Churchill Downs, a \$76,000 maiden allowance event for two-year-olds going seven-furlongs on the main track. This bay son of Flatter returns to the races off a near four-month hiatus for trainer Ben Colebrook but is capable of a solid effort fresh, as he was a good second on debut at Belmont Park back in early May. I can forgive his sixth-place finish at Ellis Park, as he pressed a quick pace from a wide post draw and tired to finish behind a pair of next-out winners, including the eventual two-year-old stakes winner Tobacco Road. He has been training forwardly, gets a good gate rider in Albin Jimenez, and this heat came up on the soft side. I’ll play (#4) **WRATH** to win and place at odds of 3-1 or greater; (#5) **FROLIC MORE**, (#9) **LAUGHING FOX**, and (#11) **RUN THIS TOWN** make sense in the exotics. —**JG**
